Acton Market Country Store: 32003 Crown Valley Road, Acton 93510; 661-269-1522. Grocery store that has many vegan options, including basic vegan sandwiches from the deli and a coffee bar with milk substitutes. Perfect for a quick snack before or after a tour! (\$-\$\$)

Don Chato: 3807 Sierra Highway, Acton 93510; 661-269-2005. Mexican restaurant with many dishes that can be made vegan including veggie tostadas, veggie burritos, and veggie fajitas. (\$-\$\$)

La Cabana: 2370 Soledad Canyon Road, Acton 93510; 661-269-4504. Mexican restaurant that has items that can be made vegan such as salads, veggie tostadas, and veggie burritos. (\$)

Miso Sushi: 3720 Sierra Highway, Acton 93510; 661-269-4050 and 44230 10th St. W., Lancaster; 661-940-6369. This sushi restaurant offers several vegan dishes. (\$-\$\$)

Wences Bistro: 3620 Smith Ave., Acton 93510; (661) 269-1888. Restaurant offering a wide variety of cuisines including Chinese and Italian. Many of the vegetable options, such as the vegetable chow mein, mu-shu vegetables, and kung pao tofu, are vegan. Many of the pasta dishes can be made vegan. (\$)

49er Saloon: 31908 Crown Valley Road, Acton 93510; 661-526-4414. This Western restaurant offers a few vegan options, including a vegan burger (the Beyond Burger) and a vegan chef special. The fried pickles are also vegan. (\$\$)

Santa Clarita:

La Charrita: 24225 Main St., Newhall 91321; 661-288-1204. La Charrita is an authentic Mexican restaurant that has a separate vegan menu offering plant-based alternatives to classic Mexican dishes. They offer many meat substitutes such as jackfruit “al pastor,” cauliflower, soyrizo, and nopales. (\$)

Hugo's: 12851 Riverside Drive, Studio City 91604; 818-761-8985. Hugo's features many vegan options and several other items that can be made vegan upon request, each clearly labeled on the menu. There is an additional location in West Hollywood. (\$\$)

Hugo's Tacos: 4749 Coldwater Canyon, Studio City 91604; 818-762-7771, and 3300 Glendale Blvd., Los Angeles; 323-664-9400. This is Hugo's sister restaurant, which serves many vegan Mexican dishes. (\$)

(V) Krimsey's Cajun Kitchen: 12900 Victory Blvd., North Hollywood 91606; (818) 308-6166. Vegan café specializing in Cajun and Creole cuisine that's also nut-free and soy-free. Offers a concise menu of mains and sides, such as jambalaya and cornbread. The hush puppies are delicious!(\$)
